

I received a scholarship to attend a study tour on energy policy sponsored by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany. The Federal Republic of Germany has a consulate in Chicago, located at 676 N Michigan Ave #3200, Chicago, IL 6611. If you have any additional questions about the trip you may reach the consulate at (312) 202-0480.

The scholarship included airport transportation at approximately \$53.50, train rides within Germany at approximately \$171.20, hotel lodging (including breakfast) for six nights at approximately \$513.60, bus rides and public transportation at approximately \$160.50, lunches and dinners at approximately \$299.60, and a cultural honoraria program at approximately \$86.67. All values have been converted to USD based on the 1:1.07 Euro to USD exchange rate during the time of the trip. The total estimated value of expenses paid for by the German Government was approximately \$1,285.07.
